Dual Credit Requirements for MSU & MCTC General Education Classes

- Students must meet College Ready Benchmarks as determined by KDE (ACT: English-18, Math-19, Reading-20)
- Grade Point Average of 3.0 or above <u>and</u> ACT Composite of 18.
- Students must enroll in, and complete, 2 courses each SEMESTER for a total of 4 courses for the year. If a student needs to DROP one of the courses, the student will DROP the ENTIRE Dual Credit Program and return to RCSHS on a daily basis to finish requirements.
- ALL courses taken through this program count for college credit AND high school credit. <u>Students are strongly encouraged to take MATH and ENGLISH 100 at the high school.</u> Students taking ENGLISH and/or MATH on campus MUST successfully complete them as part of high school graduation requirements.
- Course timeframes must be 8:00—11:00 am. Students MUST be back in the school by 11:00am.
- Course fees are paid by parents/students. Tuition is TBD by participating institutions. Book fees are paid by parents/students—price varies by course.
- Each student will have 2 dual credit scholarships that they can use to pay for 2 of the 4 courses, if the student did not use them as a JR. These scholarships will be applied by the student in the Fall 2022. Ms. Gussler will notify students when the scholarship site opens and when the deadline to apply. Applying for scholarships is the responsibility of the student.

Dual Credit - Vocational Requirements HVAC, Carpentry, Welding

- Grade Point Average of 2.0 or above.
- Students will enroll in, and complete, 2 courses each semester for a total of 4 courses for the year. If a student needs to DROP one of the courses, the student will DROP the entire dual credit vocational courses and will return to RCSHS on a daily basis.
- ALL courses taken through this program count for college credit AND high school credit.
- Course timeframes must be 8:00—11:00 am. Students MUST be back in the school by 11:00am.
- Bus transportation is provided for students who need transportation.
- Students will have 2 dual credit scholarships and 2 work ready scholarships to pay for ALL 4 of the courses. These scholarships will be applied in the Fall 2022. Ms. Gussler will notify students when the scholarship site opens and when the deadline to apply. Applying for scholarships is the responsibility of the student.
